

Privacy Policy

Your privacy is especially important to us. At Christ Church Chelmsford we have a few fundamental principles that we follow:

We do not ask you for personal information unless we truly need it. (We cannot stand services that ask you for things like your gender or income level for no apparent reason.)

We do not share your personal information with anyone except to comply with the law or protect our rights.

We do not store personal information on our servers unless required for the on-going operation of our site.

It is Christ Church Chelmsford's policy to respect your privacy regarding any information we may collect while operating our websites.

Website Visitors

Like most website operators, Christ Church Chelmsford collects non-personally-identifying information of the sort that web browsers and servers typically make available, such as the browser type, language preference, referring site, and the date and time of each visitor request. Christ Church Chelmsford's purpose in collecting non-personally identifying information is to better understand how Christ Church Chelmsford's visitors use its website. From time to time, Christ Church Chelmsford may release non-personally-identifying information in the aggregate, e.g., by publishing a report on trends in the usage of its website.

Christ Church Chelmsford also collects potentially personally-identifying information like Internet Protocol (IP) addresses for logged in users and for users leaving comments on our blogs. Christ Church Chelmsford only discloses logged in user and commenter IP addresses under the same circumstances that it uses and discloses personally-identifying information as described below, except that blog commenter IP addresses are visible and disclosed to the administrators of the blog where the comment was left.

Gathering of Personally-Identifying Information

Certain visitors to Christ Church Chelmsford's websites choose to interact with Christ Church Chelmsford in ways that require Christ Church Chelmsford to gather personally-identifying information. The amount and type of information that Christ Church Chelmsford gathers depends on the nature of the interaction. For example, we ask visitors who comment on our blog to provide a username and email address. Those who wish to receive Christ Church Chelmsford updates via email, we collect their emails. In each case, Christ Church Chelmsford collects such information only insofar as is necessary or appropriate to fulfil the purpose of the visitor's interaction with Christ Church Chelmsford. Christ Church Chelmsford does not disclose personally-identifying information other than as described below. And visitors can always refuse to supply personally-identifying information, with the caveat that it may prevent them from engaging in certain website-related activities.

Aggregated Statistics

Christ Church Chelmsford may collect statistics about the behaviour of visitors to its websites. For instance, Christ Church Chelmsford may monitor the most popular pages on the christchurchchelmsford.co.uk site. Christ Church Chelmsford may display this information publicly or provide it to others. However, Christ Church Chelmsford does not disclose personally-identifying information other than as described below.

Protection of Certain Personally-Identifying Information

Christ Church Chelmsford discloses potentially personally-identifying and personally-identifying information only to those of its office staff. Christ Church Chelmsford will not rent or sell potentially personally-identifying and personally-identifying information to anyone. If you are a registered user of Christ Church Chelmsford website and have supplied your email address, Christ Church Chelmsford may occasionally send you an email to tell you about new events, solicit your feedback, or just keep you up to date with what is going on with Christ Church Chelmsford. Christ Church Chelmsford takes all measures reasonably necessary to protect against the unauthorized access, use, alteration or destruction of potentially personally-identifying and personally-identifying information.

Cookies

A cookie is a string of information that a website stores on a visitor's computer, and that the visitor's browser provides to the website each time the visitor returns. Christ Church Chelmsford uses cookies to help Christ Church Chelmsford identify and track visitors, their usage of Christ Church Chelmsford website, and their website access preferences. Christ Church Chelmsford visitors who do not wish to have cookies placed on their computers should set their browsers to refuse cookies before using Christ Church Chelmsford's websites, with the drawback that certain features of Christ Church Chelmsford's websites may not function properly without the aid of cookies.

Privacy Policy Changes

Although most changes are likely to be minor, Christ Church Chelmsford may change its Privacy Policy from time to time, and in Christ Church Chelmsford's sole discretion. Christ Church Chelmsford encourages visitors to frequently check this page for any changes to its Privacy Policy.
